Report From the Fly on the Wall (or What is Going On In the Classroom)

Math: In fourth grade, students learned to multiply 2 digit by 2 digit numbers using an area model. In our first unit, we will extend our knowledge to multiply three digit by 2 digit numbers with an area model, with our end in mind being connecting the area model to the standard algorithm for multiplication.

<u>Science:</u> Our first quarter focus is Ecosystems. In this unit, we will be learning the difference between terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems as well as comparing multiple biomes.

Reading: It is important to be engaged in what we read, so we are learning how to make connections to texts. Connections can be made from text-to-text, text-to-self, and text-to-world. As we are reading, we are also learning to make inferences by using what we know as well as the information the text gives us to come to a conclusion. As you read with your child at home, encourage them to make connections and inferences

<u>Writing:</u> We are writing personal narratives as we learn about the importance of details in writing.
